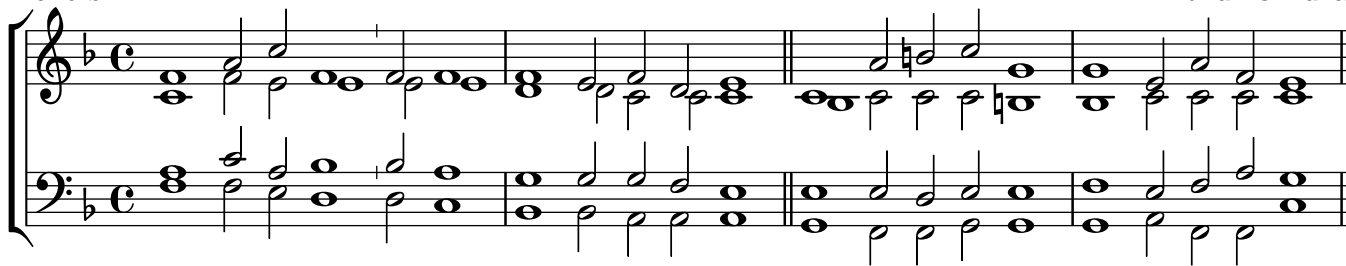


Psalm 13
